The Hudson Economic Development Corporation (HEDC) is sponsoring its 3rd annual candidate forum, Friday, October 7, beginning at eight o'clock in the morning, at the Country Club of Hudson, 2155 Middleton Road, Hudson.

All six candidates for Hudson City Council – Dan Williams, Dennis Hanink, Dave Basil, Alex D. Klemen, Derran Kent Wimer, and John W. Jeffers; Hudson School Board candidates James D. Field, Gary Mushock, Sarah G. Norman, and Darlene Szilagy; and both candidates for mayor – incumbent Mayor William Currin and challenger David Hack were invited to participate.
