HEDC endorses school levy, city issues

Hudson Economic Development Corp. trustees voted to endorse Issues 1, 33 and 34 at its Oct. 15 meeting.

"We believe that passage of Issue 1, the 5.9-mill Hudson City School District continuing operating levy, is critical not just to the financial stability and success of our schools, but to the financial stability and success of our community," said HEDC president Jill Bacon Madden. "Maintaining an excellent school district contributes to economic development and the quality of life in Hudson. As the schools go -- so goes the community.

"Issues 33 and 34 are important changes to the city's charter that will help Hudson to be more responsive and business friendly," she added. "It's important to remember that Issue 34, which shortens the time for approval of streets and land subdivision and eliminates the requirement to hold a public hearing on industrial streets, only affects our out-lying industrial districts: 6 and 8."
